There are five classes; you can enter just one, several, or all of them. The choice is yours. Each class you successfully compete in will earn you a number of points.

There is a Championship Award which will be won by the Barefoot Horse which gains the most points on the day.



CLASSES:

MINI TRAIL RIDE

To be ridden at a minimum average of 200mpm. Section A road work – walk only - high vis must be worn, Section B stony track - any pace, Sections C grass & woods – any pace, Section D through water – any pace

HEALTH, HOOF & TURNOUT

Showing class judged on quality of feet, body condition (overweight horses will be marked down), soundness & turnout. Competitors to present in whatever showing attire suits them. This is not a beauty class!

DRESSAGE

Short arena. Choose from Walk & Trot – BD Intro A (2008) Prelim 7 (2002) Novice 24 (2010)

SHOW JUMPING

Approx. 9 fences - 50cms, 60cms, 70cms. Schooling rounds running concurrently

CROSS COUNTRY

Approx. 9 fences inc ditch and water – 50cms, 70cms

SCORING:

Potential 10 marks each for Trail Ride, Health, Hoof and Turnout, SJ, XC & Dressage = possible 50 marks, Hoof Boots and bitless bridles may be used at the owner's/handler's own risk.

Entirely barefoot horses which pass the soundness test will be eligible for a special award.

ENTRIES:

All competitors must enter in advance, online at www.pachesham.com by Monday 1st September.

£45 for all 5 phases, or you may enter just the Trail ride and dressage in advance for £20 and pay cash on the day if you decide to show and jump, so Health & Condition Class, SJ & XC can be entered on the day @ £10 each. Schooling rounds £10 at the ringside. Competitors do not need to do all sections but will reduce their potential score by not doing so.

REFUNDS – No refunds after the closing date except with a Dr or Vet note for 50% refund.

BAREFOOT PERFORMANCE CHAMPION

Trophy, rosette and £50

PRIZES – Reserve Champion Rosette and £25 plus Award Rosettes to overall 3rd to 10th.

1st - 4th for each Dressage level and a prize for overall highest percentage.

A Rosette for all who jump clear over both SJ & XC

1st - 4th for Condition Class + bag of super yummy herbal treats to all who gain full marks for condition.

Anticipated time of unmounted final awards 3.30pm

MORE INFORMATION

Riders may ride the trail in pairs. Hi-Vis clothing must be worn (for the roadwork).

Each jumping fault will incur -1 from maximum score. A rider fall -5, horse fall or 3 refusals = 0 points for that phase. Dressage and Jumping will be on grass. You may ride 2 dressage tests instead of one jumping phase, (add £10 to advance entry).

The Canteen will be open all day serving a delicious range of food and drink.

Overnighters welcome - easy access and parking.

To enter online you will first need to register as a website customer and then proceed to the entering part. Paypal will take your money by credit card if you don't have a Paypal account. Alternatively you can tick the 'pay by cheque' option and post your cheque in good time (slow post round here).
